We are delighted that you have chosen to worship God with our family. Should you have any questions about the service, do not hesitate to ask someone sitting next to you. We are very glad to help.

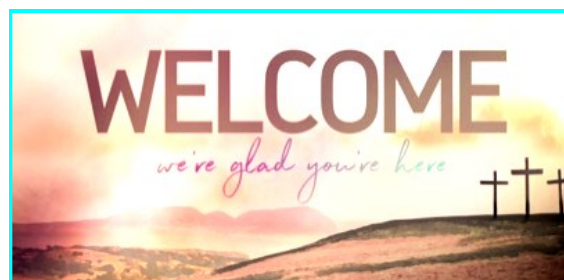
